

Electronic Devices Policy

Student Policy 5402 Approved: 2/23/2016

I. PURPOSE

Electronic devices in the classroom can serve both to enhance and disrupt a student's learning opportunities. Athlos Academy acknowledges that the landscape of educational technology is ever-changing and has put the following policy in place to properly govern the permitted uses of electronic devices at Athlos Academy.

II. DEFINITIONS

A. Electronic Device: A device that is used for audio, video, or text communication or any other type of computer or computer-like instrument.

III. POLICY

- A. Students of Athlos Academy may possess electronic devices at school subject to the following conditions:
 - 1. Students may carry and possess electronic devices to and from school.
 - 2. Electronic devices must be turned off and kept in lockers during school hours except if otherwise allowed by a school teacher or administrator.
 - 3. Students shall be personally and solely responsible for the security of their electronic devices.
 - a. The school shall not assume responsibility for theft, loss, damage, or unauthorized calls made with a student's electronic device.
 - 4. Students may use their electric device if the use is established by the appropriate administrator to be necessary for other special circumstances, health-related reasons, or emergency.
- B. Students may not use electronic devices pursuant to the following:
 - 1. Students are not allowed to possess personal electronic devices during the school day without permission.
 - 2. At no time is a personal electronic device or any device capable of taking photographs allowed in restrooms, locker rooms or dressing rooms.
 - 3. For gaming, personal social media, watching videos, listening to music, or during lunch, between classes or before or after school on school premises without adult supervision.

- 4. In ways that bully, humiliate, harass, or intimidate students or school employees consistent with *Student Policy 5401*.
- 5. During standardized assessments unless specifically permitted by statute, the student's IEP, or assessment directions.
- C. If a student violates this policy, his/her electronic device may be confiscated by any Athlos Academy of St. Cloud teacher or administrator.
 - 1. After the first confiscation, the device will be returned to the student at the end of the school day.
 - 2. On subsequent confiscations, the device will be released only to the student's parent/guardian(s), after the student has complied with the disciplinary consequences.
 - 3. The school may examine a student's personal device and search its contents if there is a reason to believe that school policies or state laws have been violated.
 - 4. In extreme cases, law enforcement may confiscate the device.
 - D. The School Leader may institute other reasonable restrictions regarding student use of cell phones and other personal electronic devices beyond those outlined in this policy.
