Sort them in different ways	Write down as many units of measurement that you remember	Ask your parent or caregiver for a chore you can do. Discuss how doing the chore made you feel and how it helped your family.	Show Grit - Complete a puzzle
Make a cozy reading fort. Read in it for 30 minutes.
