

E-LEARNING DAY

- E-Learning Days are for students so they can still engage in learning during inclement weather (snow) days. On an E-Learning Day, students in grades K-5 will continue learning from home, with support from their teachers, instead of going to school. Teachers will share curriculum-aligned assignments, school computer programs, and/or Choice (BINGO) Boards. Teachers will be accessible during their office hours in order to provide learning support to students. The grade level schedules are below.

- Snow Days vs E-Learning Days

Snow Days are days where students are not expected to do additional academic school work.

E-Learning days are intended to counter the loss of curriculum momentum resulting from school cancellations due to Minnesota's winter weather conditions. E-Learning Days cannot replace the face-to-face time students have with their teachers, but they can provide better learning continuity when school is interrupted. E-Learning Days also negate the need for makeup school days in June, helping families more effectively plan summer activities.

When are E-Learning Days Used?

At Athlos, our first weather related closure will be used as a Snow Day.

The next five weather related closings will be shifted to E-Learning days. Additional weather related school closing days will be determined by Kate Hill, Assistant Executive Director, and makeup time for students and/or staff will be determined by Kate Hill.
