The culture in the building is positive with students and staff. Behavior referrals have seen a 1/3 drop. We are working with the bus company to manage bus behaviors. Last Friday was a staff development day that went well. Chandler, from home court, was here last week to offer support to the Athletic coaches. Darin was here last week to visit and observe classrooms. Josh Koenig was here to offer technology support with the laptops, ipads, projectors, etc. All K-3 classrooms are utilizing ipads. Gym Acoustics	Aaron is concerned with the sound in the gym and the staff that work in there all day. Aaron has been talking to Brian at St Cloud Acoustics to test the sound in the gym and come up with a plan to control the sound. Sound is registering at 5.5 seconds on reverberation, should be 2. The board discussed the estimate provided to supply panels to absorb the sound. \$37,000 bid for just the wall panels, which was recommended by St. Cloud Acoustics.
